

The Columbus Bar Association's Minority Clerkship Program (MCP) was established in 1987, and is a collaboration of the CBA, The Ohio State University Moritz College of Law, and Capital University Law School.

STUDENT INFORMATION

The program's immediate goal is to provide legal experience and education for racial and ethnic Minority law students through summer placement at local law firms, government agencies and corporate offices. The program focuses on arranging clerkship positions for first and second year students.


To apply to the clerkship program, first- and second-year Minority students (from The Ohio State University Moritz College of Law and Capital University Law School only) must submit their application and attend mandatory learning sessions, as well as participate in a mentoring program.



Clerkships typically begin late May and early June and end by mid-August.



While some MCP clerks are asked to return or interview for the following summer, the MCP relationship only extends through the summer clerkship period.
